

Generate VME0001 & VME0005 Errors When a Facility & Wells are Missing for Current Month

Audience: All Saskatchewan Users

Purpose: To notify users that effective January 20, 2023, the volumetric reporting deadline for the December 2022 production month, Petrinex will generate both VME0001 and VME0005 errors when both the facility and linked wells are ACTIVE and no volumetric activities have been submitted for the production month.

Saskatchewan Ministry of Energy and Resources is implementing a three-month shadow billing period for the VME0005 errors. Live billing will commence for any VME0005 errors that are unresolved as of the volumetric reporting deadline for the March 2023 production month.

Background: Prior to this change, for the current production month, Petrinex checked to see if an ACTIVE facility has reported volumetric activities. If no activities were reported, a "VME0001 – Facility is missing" error is generated. The "VME005 - Well is missing" error was generated only when volumetric activity has been reported at the facility with no activity reported at the ACTIVE linked wells.
