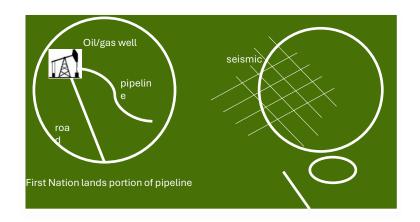

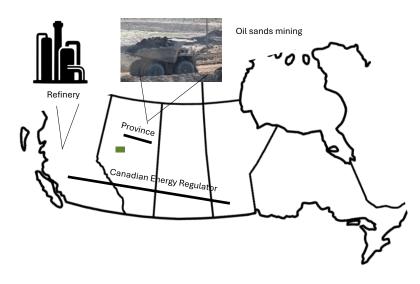

Month 4

REN Notifications are created and sent out. Royalty Statements with RM data sent out by Finance









Month 3

Reporting will be going out by the **20th**. Payment of royalties due for production month by the 25th



Royalty Payor/Operator submits volumetric data to Petrinex platform by the 20th of the month

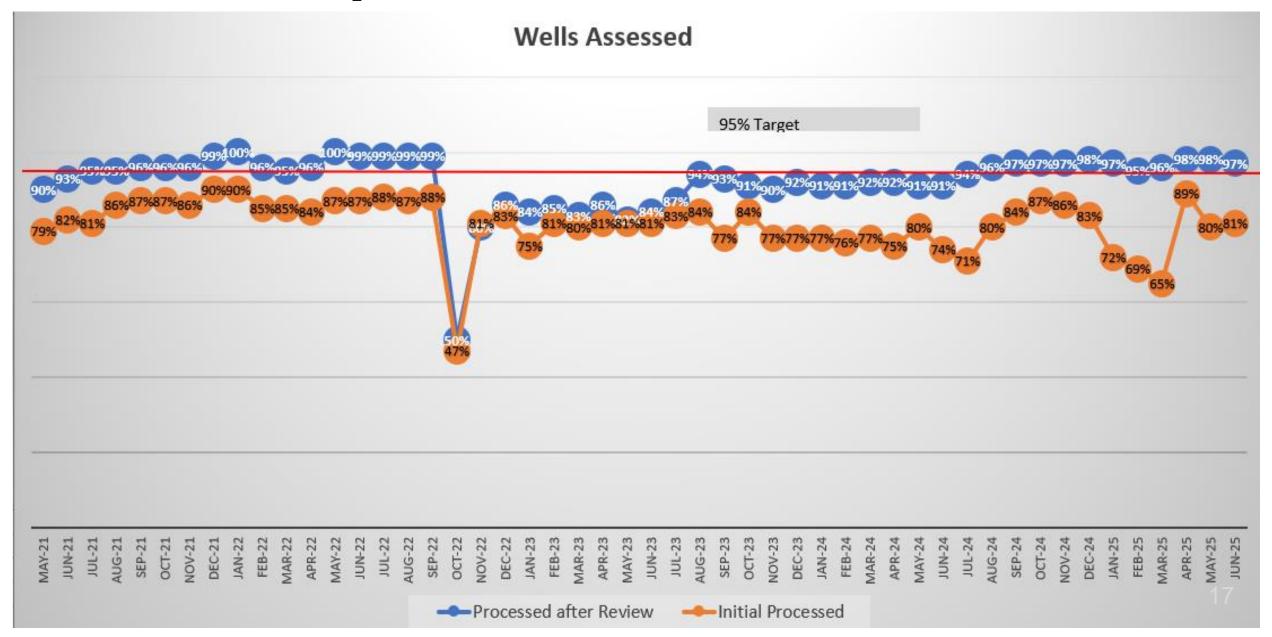
Prior Periods Clean – Up

- During IOGC Royalty Module (RM) implementation, both IOGC Electronic Data Submission (EDS) and Petrinex were run in parallel for some time
- IOGC is working on ensuring all data prior to August 2024 cut off is in the old IOGC Resource Information Management System (RIMS1 system) – submission through EDS
- We will be reaching out to affected parties for inputs
- Once all data is in the system, the old system will be locked
- All new submissions will require IOGC approval

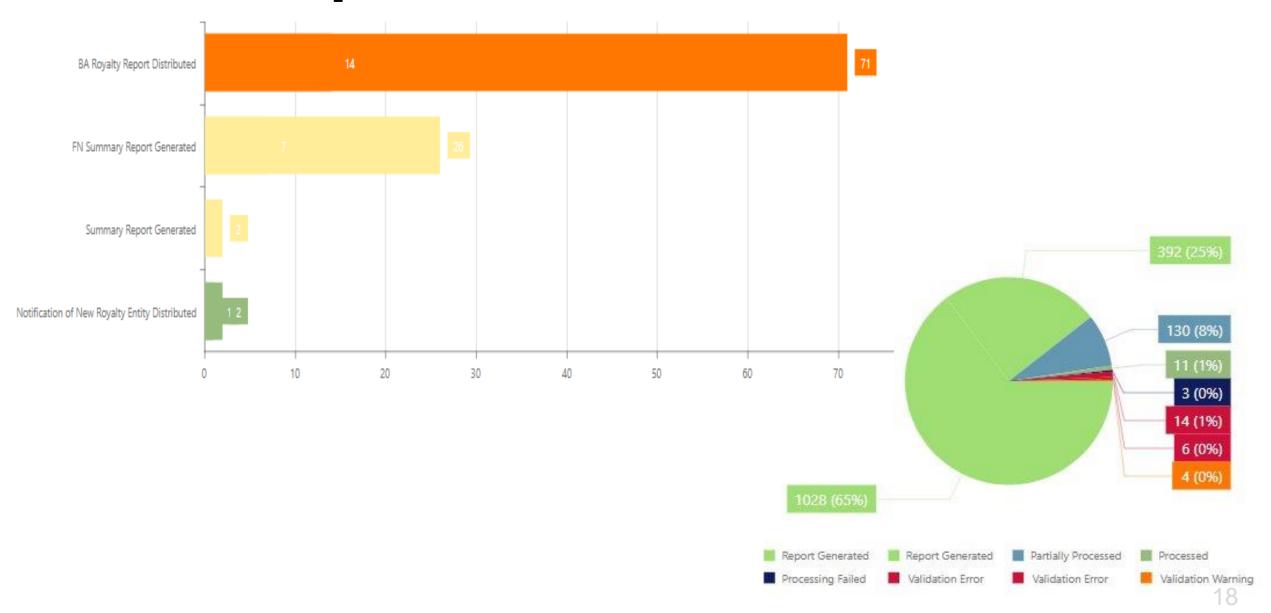
Royalty Module (RM) Inputs

- Gas Pricing the total Revenue and total Volumes/ Energy sold are inputted, not First Nation share.
- Important: Please check your contracts to determine if sales or reference prices are required (no need to submit sales prices when the reference price is specified).
- If the price is not submitted IOGC, we will use reference price for provisional assessment.

Royalty Module (RM) Inputs

- Royalty Tax Payor (RTP) needs to be amended or set up as soon as possible to ensure the reports are sent to proper party (15th of the month is the cut-off period for the next month's reports)
- New well linked to the facility as soon as possible to ensure there is no delay in the processing

- Ensure the BA User Security Administrator (USA) has assigned all IOGC reports to the designated personnel to avoid any delay in receiving the reports and notifications

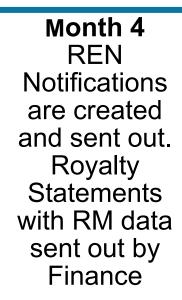

Gas Cost Allowance (GCA)

Avoid Complications With Regular Submissions

- GCA 1s Ensure timely submissions for new set-ups and/or changes to Operator, Working Interest Owners, Related Facilities (gas flow) and/or Well Linkages of existing Facility Cost Centre's. Petrinex sends a notification to BAs to inform them of changes that may have an IOGC GCA obligation.
- Please ensure the status of the GCA forms has been changed from "Open" to "Submitted". It has not been submitted to IOGC for processing until this status has changed and submit button hit.
- Rates do not automatically transfer from one BA to another. Must submit all corresponding GCA 1s to ensure the change.

Reminder: You have 30 days to report new facilities or make changes to existing FCC's before it will affect the period the GCA rate will be applicable.

Gas Cost Allowance (GCA)

- If you are a Working Interest Owner (WIO) in a non-operated FCC, it is your responsibility to work with the Operator of that Facility to ensure they have listed you as WIO, or you will not receive a rate for this facility.
- If you are entitled to a Custom Processing Fee (CPF) for an FCC, (and you are not a WIO), you need to ensure the Operator has submitted a GCA 1 for the FCC. This will allow you to generate a GCA 2 for the FCC and to submit the rate as per the contract agreement.
- When calculating volumes please ensure all volumes utilizing the FCC for the entire year, are reported. Regardless, of the effective date of the FCC.

Gas Cost Allowance (GCA)

- For allowable capital and operating costs, refer to the Royalty Reporting Guidelines – GCA Section. If the costs are not listed as an allowable cost, they are considered non-allowable.
- Capital additions for replacements will require the original capital to be retired.
 If you do not know the original cost submitted as per the AFE, you must retire 50% of the new capital.
- In case of a "rejection" status, please re-submit within 10 days, as per Petrinex standards.
- Please terminate all FCCs no longer required by December 31, 2025.

Requirement:

IOGC requires a map that illustrates alignment in the field infrastructure and gas flows from the field schematic to the corresponding IOGC FCC at setup.

Frequency:

Initial map required with GCA 1 submission – thereafter, only when there is change in information.

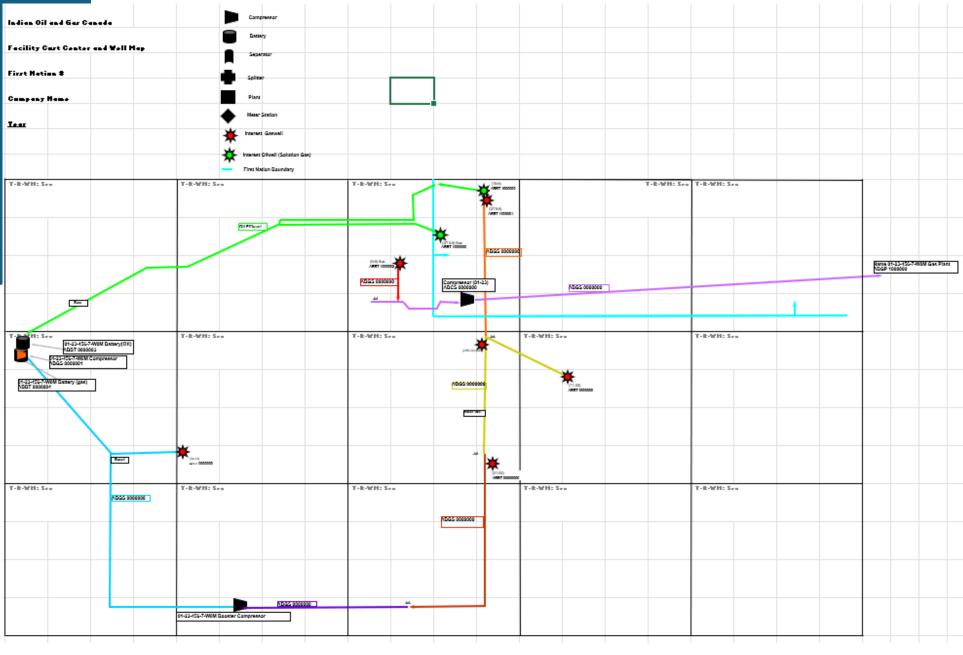
Approach:

Initially Pilot with 5 Companies First, then full roll-out for all – Projected 2026.

Royalty Payments and Financial Statements

- IOGC requires the Royalty Statement as backup when a company wants to reallocate separate from the payment
- Finance still requires a Remittance Advice or a Lease schedule as backup
- Email <u>iogcfinance@sac-isc.gc.ca</u> with the backup
- Refrain from sending paper copies of Remittance advices send through email
- IOGC is automating the REN creation process and is working to resolve some issues that have been brought forward
- IOGC is encouraging Payors to get on EFT(Electronic Funds Transfer) Let us know
- IOGC is working on a solution for emailing Land Statements we are exploring our options using Petrinex is one option similarly how you currently receive the Royalty Statements.
- Invoice and Reminders letters will be coming soon to Lease holders/Payors
- IOGC is creating Contract Holder statements, so you are aware of your obligations
