Audience: All Stakeholders

Purpose: This alert outlines changes to the Allocation OAF and Allocation WIO reports that are designed to make these reports more efficient.

Background: In the past, both the OAF and WIO reports could be requested by Operators and Non-operators. There were two differences between the reports:

1. The OAF report displayed both the calculated and submitted volume and energy, while the WIO report only contained the calculated volume and energy.
2. On the OAF report, operators (submitters) could request one or All owners, but non-operators could only request data for their own BA. With the WIO report, operators and non-operators could only request data from their own BA.

The WIO report was a newer and more efficient report than the OAF report and as such permitted larger report requests to be successfully processed. Owners whose volumes cascaded through multiple facilities would often have to run the OAF report in addition to the WIO report if one of the cascade levels did not respond/report for an optional partner reporting item. This meant the Registry could not calculate the volume even if the upstream operator submitted volume information. The revised WIO will show calculated and submitted volume and/or energy information.



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Key Principles:

Allocation OAF Report

As of September 7, 2006, the OAF report will be an Operator Only report.

Only the operator who submitted the allocation will receive results when requesting the OAF report.

In addition to this, the ability to select owners has been removed. All Owners will be returned for each report request. Removing the owner selection impacts any CSV saved report parameters. The user will need to edit their saved OAF CSV report request by deleting the owner column. If this is not done, the Registry will reject the upload.

This change is expected to bring more efficiency to the OAF report by concentrating on Operator submissions only.

Allocation WIO Report

As of September 7, 2006, the WIO report was enhanced to add the submitted volume and energy information.

This is in addition to the calculated volume and energy values that were already available in this report.

The WIO report continues to be exclusively for allocated owner information for non-operated and/or operated properties.
