Linking and Reporting Licensed Water Source Wells

- Audience:** Registry users responsible for linking water source wells to facilities.
- Purpose:** This Tip identifies linking and reporting requirements for licensed water source wells.
- Key Principles:**
- Linking**
A user can only link water source wells to an injection facility (type IF) or to a battery (BT with a subtype 902). Wells can be linked to a single facility of either type, but not to two facilities at the same time.
- Reporting Volume**
It is a requirement of the Registry that a user must report water volume from these wells as the activity PROD, along with the product, hours and volume. If the user has linked the water source well to a BT and report the PROD activity there, then they need to report a receipt at the IF from the BT in order to have the IF balance.
- The Registry has incorporated a code table to allow PROD to be reported at an IF.
- If operators attach the well to an IF and report the PROD activity there, the summary screen and facility balancing reports will reflect the PROD activity.



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
