# Enhancements to the Well Infrastructure Report

**Audience:** All Stakeholders

**Purpose:** This Tip outlines enhancements to the **Well Infrastructure Report**.

**Background:** The **Well Infrastructure Report** historically contained information related to the well (license #, pool code, etc.) and royalty related information (Production entity (PE) ID, Vintage, Crown Interest, etc.). Only wells that had been issued a PE ID were included on the report.

Over the last few months the royalty related information has also been included on a couple of new Registry reports. The **Production Entity (PE) Report** contains all the royalty information such as Crown Interest and Vintage. The **Royalty Attribute Change Report** summarizes changes to the royalty information.

Now that these new royalty information reports are available, in the Registry, this data has been removed from the **Well Infrastructure Report**.

**Procedures:** Effective April 3, 2008, the **Well Infrastructure Report** is now limited to well information. The report will include records (if requested) for all/any existing Registry well including ones without a PE ID (abandoned or drilled and cased well status).

How to access the report request has not changed however, selection options have changed:

- Production Entity Id has been removed
- Licensee has been added
- Undefined Pool has been added



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In addition, a number of new list builders for the Pools - both defined and undefined, as well as one for Field/Area have been added to allow users to select a list of these items. Previously the selection was All or One.

*NOTE: Any users who have been using the Saved Report Parameters will need to create a new saved report parameter using the new submission options.*

This information will be updated and available in the Registry Training Module 9.4 – Request Well Infrastructure Report.
