APMC Crown Royalty Oil Forecast Confirmation Report

Audience: All Stakeholders

Purpose: The Purpose of this tip is to advise users of a new APMC report available on the Registry to allow producers to see any variance between royalty forecast volumes and actual delivered royalty volumes. It is anticipated that this will assist producers in improving the forecasting accuracy of the Crown's volumes.

Background: Over the past several years, the APMC has held meetings and discussions with various industry groups regarding the importance of accuracy in forecasting of all crude oil deliveries. Pipeline capacity issues in the near future may create apportionment which could place more pressure on pipelines, shippers, and producers to improve the accuracy of forecasting to avoid costly reporting errors.

These reports are intended for the person responsible for Form A Forecasting for the operator. If the person who has access to Ministry Invoices and Statements is not the one responsible for forecasting, it is requested that these reports be forwarded to the appropriate person, or provide access to that individual to Ministry Invoices and Statements.

These reports will be available on the last business day of the month in accordance with production months and dates shown on the Registry Calendar.

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
