Water Reporting Clarification

Audience: All Stakeholders

Purpose: This tip reminds users that the Energy Resources Conservation Board (ERCB) **requires all reporting facilities** to report their water volumes in the Petroleum Registry of Alberta (Registry) on a monthly basis.

Background: Reporting facilities: Batteries (BT), Custom Treaters (CT), Gathering Systems (GS), Gas Plants (GP), Injection Facilities (IF), Meter Stations (MS), Pipelines (PL), Refineries (RF), Terminals (TM) and Waste Plants (WP) that have water volumes (including S&W) of 0.1 m³ and greater per month must report in the Registry.

The ERCB will be following up with operators who do not report water based on the type of facility.

Operators will not be required to submit prior month amendments to report missing water volumes unless otherwise directed by the ERCB.
