**Audience:** All Stakeholders

**Purpose:** This tip informs users that the Registry has a new report for ensuring all required Oil & Condensate Production SAF/OAF's have been submitted.

**UPDATE: With the end of the Drilling Royalty Credit Program, this report will no longer be available as of June 30, 2011.**

**Until that date users can run the report to list errors or missing data associated with SAF/OAFs amendments submitted for the products Oil & Condensate for the activity of Production up to and including March 2011 production ONLY.**

**Background:** The Drilling Royalty Credit program has resulted in the DOE requiring additional SAF/OAF allocation information, effective January 2009 for Oil and Condensate production volumes reported in the Registry's volumetric process.

**Procedure:** **Effective December 3, 2009** a new Report called the OIL/COND PROD Ensure Complete Report is available on the Registry. This is a different report from the existing SAF/OAF Ensure Complete Report which is for Gas and LPG crown royalty trigger items.

This new report is located on the Registry menu under

**Monthly Reporting – Allocations – Request OIL/COND PROD Ensure Complete Report.**

The report can be requested at anytime for the user's operated facilities. The report is a daytime running report and can be requested for a maximum of two (2) production months at a time, and is available in PDF and CSV formats.

This new report will list errors or missing data associated with SAF/OAFs submitted for the products Oil & Condensate for the activity of Production for the months 2009-01 and forward.

NOTE: This task has been included in the Registry Comprehensive Role. If you have a role other than the Registry Comprehensive Role, and this task is not available on your menu, please check with your User Security Administrator to have it added to your role.
