

## **VME0035 Warning – Updated Vent Volume Limits**

**Audience:** All Stakeholders

**Purpose:** This tip informs users that effective September 6, 2017 (August production month), the Alberta Energy Regulator has updated the VME0035 warning message and decreased the vent limit from 30 e<sup>3</sup>m<sup>3</sup> to 15 e<sup>3</sup>m<sup>3</sup> per month.

**Background:** To align with the [Venting Compliance Program](#) announcement, the AER has implemented changes to the current VME0035 vent volume limits.

Effective August production month, when the sum of vented volumes reported at the well and facility level exceeds 15 e<sup>3</sup>m<sup>3</sup>, the operator will receive a VME0035 warning message.

This warning will also be included on the AER Noncompliance Report, and as CAI (119 and 121) on the AER Compliance Assessment Report.
