

## New Waste Location Description for Oilfield Spill Material During Transportation

**Audience:** All AB Waste Plant Operators

**Purpose:** To notify stakeholders of the new waste location ID description created for oilfield spill material location released during transportation.

**Background:** Previous AER direction was to code off-site release locations in transportation as NONOFD waste which had potential to impact waste receivers non-oilfield volume limitations outlined in approvals and/or restricted operators from accepting their own waste into a waste component approval due to the waste code being used.

**Key Principles:** Effective September 6<sup>th</sup>, waste plant operators are able to create a waste location ID for off-site spill material that was released during transport utilizing the new description "Oilfield Spill during Transportation Release Location" in the Waste Location description drop down. This is the one exception from Directive 047 where an oilfield waste code can be applied to an ABWL location. The ABWL location must be created for the spill/release location and the material released must have originated from an AER regulated upstream petroleum location. The waste material must still be properly characterized and classified and the appropriate oilfield waste code applied to the material.
