<u>Volumetrics – Updated Functionality of SK CO Node for</u> <u>Disposition of Spec Products at Gas Plants</u>

Audience: All Saskatchewan Users

Purpose: To inform Industry that effective the January 3, 2019 Petrinex release, the

Ministry of Energy and Resources (ER) has expanded functionality of the Miscellaneous Node – SK CO - Commercial in Petrinex to allow the reporting of disposition (DISP) of spec product from gas plants to commercial customers

that do not have a Petrinex facility code.

Background: ER functionality of Miscellaneous Node - SK CO - Commercial will be

expanded to allow operators of gas plants (GP) to report disposition of spec products to commercial customers that do not have Petrinex facility code. The allowable spec products for disposition (DISP) at GP are C3-MX, C3-SP, C4-

MX, C4-SP, C5-MX, and C5-SP.

The updated functionality better aligns with <u>Directive PNG032</u> and allows operators of gas plants to correctly utilize Saskatchewan's Miscellaneous Node – SK CO – Commercial, and avoid use of another SK MC – Miscellaneous node.

This change is effective on the go forward basis from 2018-12 production month, as well as to volumetric amendments made in the prior production months.
