Audience: All Alberta Stakeholders

Purpose: To notify stakeholders of the revised edition of Manual 011: How to Submit Volumetric Data to the AER (Manual 011).

Background: Alberta Methane Reduction requirements have resulted in changes to Directive 060 & Directive 017 regarding flared/incinerated *acid* gas reporting, which become mandatory effective January 1, 2020. The updates to Manual 011 make it consistent with the latest editions of Directive 060: Upstream Petroleum Industry Flaring, Incinerating, and Venting & Directive 017: Measurement Requirements for Oil and Gas Operations.

Key Principles: The specific changes which were made in Manual 011 affected the activity codes in Appendix 1, and the wording around acid gas in Appendix 9.
