

## Changes to the Lahee Classification in Petrinex

**Audience:** All stakeholders

**Purpose:** To notify Petrinex users that the Lahee Classification field in Petrinex is renamed to the AER Classification

**Background:** As per Alberta Energy Regulator (AER) Bulletin 2019-22 dated October 3, 2019 the Lahee classification system has been replaced with AER classification, one that distinguishes between exploration and exploitation activity while taking into account other unique well types drilled in Alberta.

**Key Principles:** With the implementation of new well licence application in OneStop starting October 17, 2019, the Lahee classification system has been replaced with the AER classification system. The revisions (changing the field name on the Query Well Screen and Well Infrastructure Report in Petrinex and the Well Licence download in the AB Public Data Portal) will bring industry up to date with the changes that have already been made within OneStop and Directive 056.
