

Requesting Petrinex Reports and Extracts

Audience: Industry Petrinex Users

Purpose: To advise Industry users about the current report selection options for the most commonly requested Petrinex reports.

Background: Petrinex is not just for data collection but also for data dissemination to ensure all authorized parties have access to the same information at the same time.

This data dissemination is accomplished via online queries of the screens, downloadable reports (in various formats) and data extracts. Over time Petrinex has increased the number of reports and extracts so that we now have 100+ reports across Alberta, Saskatchewan, British Columbia, Manitoba, and Indian Oil and Gas Canada lands.

Please note common behaviours for report requests:

1. All reports are run in Petrinex as part of the daytime running schedule. Depending on the size of the report request, if the report takes longer than 3 minutes to process it will be moved into the nightly queue and an e-mail notification will be sent to the requester advising them of such.
2. "Ensure/Complete" and "Non-Compliance" types of reports will continue to be scheduled as daytime reports regardless of processing time.
3. Extract requests provide users with options regarding the timing of the start for creation of the extract:

- a. Daytime 6:00 am MT to close
 - b. Nightly 5:30 pm MT to morning (default)
 - c. After Close 9:00 pm MT to morning
4. The report format PDF can generate reports that are 100s or 1,000s of pages. Petrinex reviews the size of the requested PDF report and in cases where the resulting pdf report will be excessive users will receive an email notification saying “The requested PDF report was not completed.” Please modify your selection parameters and try again.

If the same report is requested in CSV and/or XML these formats will generally result in reports being returned even if the PDF format is not completed.

Below are the most commonly requested reports or extracts including information about their report/extract selection options. These options will ensure the data is available as quickly and efficiently as possible.

Allocation – OAF report – This report is available in CSV, XML and PDF formats. This report shows your BA’s net owner share of volume and/or energy by stream for selected products and activities over a specified period. This report is accessible only to BAs named as owners for a stream. There is no limit to the number of months or facilities that may be requested. Users will always receive the most current record for the period requested.

Allocation – WIO report – This report is available in CSV, XML and PDF formats. This report provides for the requesting BA, gross and net owner share of volumes and/or energy, by stream, for each applicable product and activity. There is no limit to the number of months or facilities that may be requested. Users will always receive the most current record for the period requested

Allocation – Variance report – This report is available in CSV, XML and PDF formats. This is an operator only report. This report shows the variance between stream/owner volumes submitted for allocations and the

total volume reported for volumetrics. This report is only accessible to the facility operator who submitted the applicable SAF. There is a limit of 12 months that may be specified in each request. Users will always receive the most current record for the period requested.

Volumetric Facility Activity Report – This report is available in CSV and PDF formats. Both operators and non-operators can get volumetric data (subject to confidentiality rules). This report identifies all activities and reported and derived volumes (and energy if applicable) for each facility and product (excluding in-stream components. Volumetric data is requested for production months, facilities, products, activities, etc. There is no limit to the number of months or facilities that may be requested. Users will always receive the most current record for the data requested.

Volumetric Industry Extract – This extract is only available in XML format and is designed for larger bulk downloads of volumetric facility activity data. Both operators and non-operators may request an Industry extract (subject to confidentiality rules) for multiple facilities and production months. As part of the extract request there are Start and End Submission dates listed as selection choices. These submission dates are “optional” with the defaults set to blank. Using the defaults (blank) will provide the most current data. If dates are supplied, only submissions made during that date range will be included in the results returned.
