**Audience:** Alberta and Manitoba Petrinex users requiring Gross Completion Interval (GCI) top, bottom and perforation/packer information.

**Purpose:** This tip outlines the data contained in the new Petrinex GCI, Perforation and Packer Report and who has access to the data.

### **Key Principles:**

GCI top, bottom and perforation/packer data is currently available on the Query Well Status screen; however, each well must be queried individually.

Effective October 3, 2024, BA users with access to the query well status functionality can request a new GCI, Perforation and Packer Report displaying this information for multiple wells, by using the Submit Report Request functionality. Petrinex security rules surrounding confidential and experimental data will apply.

The report will run during the daytime queue by default. However, if the request is too large, users will receive a notification that it has been moved to the overnight queue and available the morning of the next day. This report has a save report function and is available in PDF, XML or CSV formats.
