# New Editions of Directive 007: Volumetric and Infrastructure Requirements and Manual 011: How to Submit Volumetric Data to the AER

#### Purpose:

To notify users that new editions of *Directive 007: Volumetric and Infrastructure Requirements* and *Manual 011: How to Submit Volumetric Data to the AER* are available on the AER website www.aer.ca.

### **Background:**

Effective January 2024, all brine-hosted mineral well and facility operators must report brine-hosted minerals activities monthly to the AER using Petrinex, in accordance with *Directive 007* and *Directive 090*. The term "operator" in Directive 007 & Manual 011 refers to an operator under the *Oil and Gas Conservation Rules* or a licensee under the *Geothermal Resource Development Rules* or *Brine-Hosted Mineral Resource Development Rules*, as the case may be.

#### **Key Principles:**

Directive 007 now includes reporting requirements for brine-hosted minerals infrastructure data & monthly volumetric activities. The directive also includes requirements to report supplementary information for oil and condensate receipts from miscellaneous facilities (ABMC) and unlinked wells.

Manual 011 now includes information on using Petrinex to report brine-hosted mineral activities, including updates to table 2 to include new brine-hosted mineral facility subtypes, and additions to appendix 7 to include new brine-hosted minerals well statuses, including statuses for reporting incidental hydrocarbon production. Minor revisions were also made for clarity and to update information that was out of date.
