Audience: AB Stakeholders

Purpose:

To advise licensees that when changing the commingled process to MU Commingling Order, the MU Commingling Approval Number must be entered.

Background:

Directive 065: *Resources Applications for Oil and Gas Reservoirs*, section 3.1.3.2 *Reporting and Administration of Commingled Production* states: If “MU Commingling Order” is selected as the “Commingling Process” in Petrinex, then the associated MU order number must also be entered.

Effective May 8, 2025, on a go-forward basis, when a licensee changes the commingled process to MU Commingling Order, an error will be displayed when the MU Commingling Approval Number is not in the correct format (MU and four numbers with no spaces between the MU and number) or not entered at all; the error must be fixed to be submitted in Petrinex.

The area-based Commingling Order “Southeastern Alberta” (MU7490), along with the list of current MU orders by field name, is posted on the AER [Commingling Orders](#) webpage.
