Pipeline splits involving waste plant facilities

Audience: Facility operators who deliver volume to waste plants which is subsequently delivered to terminals, and need to report a pipeline split on the volume.

Purpose: To explain how to identify the pipeline split in the Registry since waste plants are not valid reporting facilities.

Principles: In the process of reporting your pipeline split you must identify the Delivering, Receiving and Custody Transfer Point (CTPF) facilities. Volumetric reporting will show:

Battery... DISP... to waste plant
Terminal... REC... from waste plant

...suggesting that for pipeline splits:

Delivering Facility = battery
Receiving Facility = waste plant
CTPF = terminal

The Registry will not accept this for pipeline splits.

Resolution: You must identify the facilities as follows:

Delivering Facility = Battery

Receiving Facility = Terminal

CTPF = Terminal

Ignore the waste plant facility for pipeline split reporting. There will be no corresponding "volume requiring split" record. These splits will always be out of balance.
