Facility Infrastructure: Returned Gas Eligible for Gas Credits

Audience: Operators that receive gas from a meter station for use at their facility as fuel or for gas lift.

Problem Description: Operators may be overlooking their eligibility for gas credits.

Resolution: You will need to set up the facility infrastructure accordingly. The operator must go to the "Edit Facility Infrastructure" menu item and select the facility ID that is receiving the gas. Under the "Returned Gas Eligible for Gas Credits" section of the screen, chose the "credit on fuel" or "credit on lift" as applicable, depending on what the gas received at the facility is being used for. Once either of those credit flags is set to "yes", the operator must also populate the field "Royalty Trigger Facility" in order to identify where the royalty was originally paid on the gas received. Once this infrastructure is set, the DOE Gas Royalty process will calculate a royalty reduction to the streams/owners named on the SAF/OAF for the gas received at the facility.
