Responding to Cascades

Audience: All stakeholders

Purpose: This tip outlines what steps clients must perform if they choose to submit their SAF/OAF allocation before they are cascaded to.

Key Principles: Clients can submit their SAF/OAF allocation before they are cascaded to but...

- They must fill in the Cascade From field
- **Note:** It is important to remember that sometimes the operator may cascade from a Gas Plant (GP), a Gathering System (GS) or a Battery. It is the downstream operator's choice from where they cascade their information.
- To ensure where the cascade is coming from, the client should contact the downstream operator to confirm the Cascade "From" facility and the "From/To".
- **Important:** You must match the Cascade From facility on your SAF/OAF allocation. If you do not:
 - Your submission will be orphaned and will not be part of the cascade
 - The will result in DOE provisional assessments
