APMC Operator Royalty Delivery Confirmation Reports

Audience: Oil Facility operators

Purpose: This tip informs stakeholders that the APMC “Operator Royalty Delivery Confirmation Report” shows changes from a terminal code to a custom treater code that should be ignored for purposes of Registry reporting.

Key Principle: Because the Registry does not accept CT codes as Custody Transfer Points, the APMC must change this code where a delivery occurs at a CT. The message “Operator reported incorrect delivery point” on the Operator Royalty Delivery Confirmation Report should be ignored in cases where the change is made from a TM to a CT. This CT code is internal to the APMC and should not be used as a Custody Transfer Point in the Registry.

Operators should not attempt to correct this situation within the Registry.

More information: The APMC has added a new error message which reads “APMC Code Change – No Action Required” to indicate this situation
