New Well Status: Gas Test Completed

Audience: All stakeholders

Purpose: This tip informs clients of the introduction, and the workings, of a new well status: **Gas Test Completed**.

Background: In the past, the Registry's **Gas Test** status would only allow a client to submit volumetric data for three production months before it had to be reported under a new status.

Any data submitted under the **Gas Test** status beyond the three-month period would be rejected.

Procedures: In response to client concerns about this limitation, the EUB created the **Gas Test Complete** status. This allows clients to submit volumetric data beyond the three production months.

Use of new Gas Test Completed status:

- For three production months, a client can use the **Gas Test** status to submit volumetric data.
- At the end of three production months, the client must change the well's status to **Gas Test Completed** for one day.
- The client can then change the well's status back to **Gas Test** for another three months.

NOTE: Clients can still only use the **Gas Test** status for three production months at a time. The **Gas Test Completed** status can be used anytime during this time period.
