Differences between DOE and Registry Ensure Complete Reports Explained

Audience: All stakeholders

Purpose: This tip outlines the major differences between DOE and Registry Ensure Complete reports.

Background: In the past, users of the Registry have been confused by the differences between the DOE and Registry versions of the Ensure/Complete report.

Key Principles: To ensure that Registry users retrieve the information they are looking for, the similarities and differences between the DOE and Registry Ensure Complete reports are outlined in the table below:

Topic	Registry SAF/OAF Ensure Complete report	DOE SAF/OAF Ensure Complete report
Timing	1) Run automatically by the Registry on the 25 th day of the month (i.e. 25 days after the month of production). This is the due date that all SAFs and OAFs should be filed in order to meet industry partner needs.	Run automatically by the DOE two days before the DOE Allocations Deadline (i.e. approx. 43 days after the month of production)



	2) This report can also be requested by the user at any time	
Error Composition	It contains <u>all outstanding</u> errors and/or omissions related to SAF/OAF crown royalty related submissions, regardless of when these errors or omissions occurred.	It contains errors and/or omissions related to submissions made since the last DOE Allocation Deadline only, and thus subject to Provisional Assessments in the upcoming DOE Gas Royalty Invoice.
Meter Station Facility Types	It does not include Meter Station imbalances.	It includes Meter Station imbalances which will be provisionally assessed against the Common Stream Operator (CSO).
Contents of Charge Types	It includes errors and/or omissions that can result in Provisional Assessment charges <u>and</u> potential missing royalty credits (Injection Credits, return fuel).	It includes errors and/or omissions that result in Provisional Assessment charges only (does not include potential missing royalty credits).
Delivery	It is delivered to the users email address and the BA Registry Inbox.	It is delivered to the BA's Ministry Invoices and Statements area of the Registry.
