sorting ability within the BA Inbox. It is also designed to

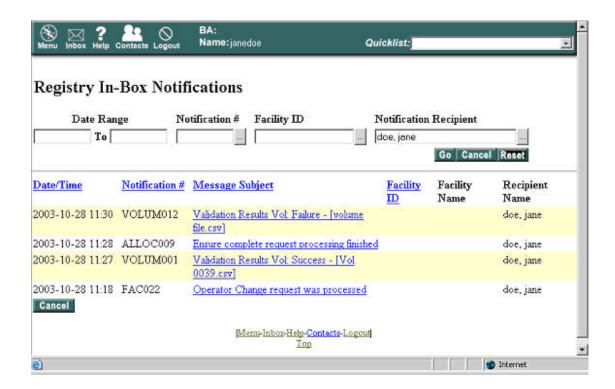
enhance the user friendliness of the Inbox.

 After viewing the details of a notification, the User will return to the same place in the Inbox where the notification is stored.

- The Inbox will continue to default to the User's notifications
- The Inbox will provide the ability to type in or use a User Lookup for the name of the Notification Recipient.
- Clicking Go will bring up the notifications with the recipient identified. Leaving the Notification Recipient box blank will retrieve notifications for all recipients.
- Clicking Reset will cause the information to reset to the default condition. This will display all notifications for the
