Purpose: This Alert outlines enhancements made to the Registry's Facility

Infrastructure report.

Backgrounder: This enhancement was brought forward as part of the pipeline split

adjustment project. The project, when implemented in April 2007, will require custody transfer point facilities to identify their level of participation in the

Registry's pipeline split process.

Enhancement of the Facility Infrastructure Report showing this participation level has a scheduled release implementation date of January 7, 2007.

Key Principles: Custody Transfer Facilities are pipelines (PL), terminals (TM) and meter

stations (MS) and operators of these facilities will have three options for

pipeline split participation:

Full – all splits to all shippers are done in the Registry not directly to the TM,

MS or PL operator.

<u>Lite</u> – splits are done outside the Registry. These facilities will require the APMC oil portion of splits to be reported to the Registry and there is an expectation the remaining splits will be loaded into the Registry for partner

reporting purposes.

Non – require the APMC portion of splits to be loaded into the Registry.

In preparation of this enhancement, the Participation Flag has been set to the default "**Non**". The participation level indicator has been added as the last column (Column AB) in the report. As individual pipelines implement a "*Full*" or "*Lite*" pipeline split approach, the Participation Flag will be changed at that

time.
