Update: Changes to the DOE Gas Royalty Invoice - New Cascade Field and Condensate Invoice

Audience: All stakeholders.

Purpose: This Alert informs users of an update to the December 2005 DOE Gas Royalty Calculation Information Bulletin, regarding changes to the Department of Energy (DOE) User Defined File (UDF) Handbook.

Key Principles: Effective with the February 2006 Gas Royalty Billing Period Invoice (sent to the Registry at the end of May 2006), two changes were made within the Gas Royalty Invoice and resulting User Defined File (UDF) Handbook:

1. A new "Response to Cascade" field was added, allowing for more information analysis on cascaded volumes;
2. Charges relating to Condensate Royalty were included within the Gas Royalty Invoice. Previously, these condensate charges were issued independently from the Gas Invoice, by mail.
