## New Facility Subtypes That Do Not Require Licenses

Audience: All Stakeholders

**Purpose:** This tip informs users of six new facility subtypes that

do not require licences and the process to be followed to set up these facilities in the Petroleum Registry.

Background: As per ERCB Directive 056 the ERCB has developed

a new process that allows them to set up facilities on

behalf of Industry that do <u>not</u> require licenses.

Industry will then be required to complete the facility setup by setting the appropriate infrastructure flags

and links.

**Key Principles:** Effective August 6, 2009 the six new facility subtypes

that do not require licenses are:

365 AB BT GAS MULTIWELL GROUP BATTERY (ISSUED BY ERCB ONLY)
366 AB BT GAS MULTIWELL PRORATION SE ALBERTA BATTERY (ISSUED BY ERCB ONLY)
367 AB BT GAS MULTIWELL PRORATION OUTSIDE SE ALBERTA BATTERY (ISSUED BY ERCB ONLY)
508 AB IF ENHANCED RECOVERY SCHEME (ISSUED BY ERCB ONLY)
509 AB IF DISPOSAL (ISSUED BY ERCB ONLY)

622 AB GS GAS GATHERING SYSTEM (PIPES ONLY OR COMPRESSOR < 75KW.) (ISSUED BY ERCB ONLY)

Operators of these facilities are required to contact ERCB's PA Helpdesk (403) 297-8952 and provide schematics of the area. Once approved, ERCB's PA Helpdesk will then be able to create the respective



facility ID. After the facility ID has been created, operators can complete the set-up process by ensuring all facility infrastructure flags are accurate and all applicable wells are linked to the new facility.
