Audience: All Saskatchewan Users

Purpose: To inform Industry that the volumetric reporting activity, Inventory Adjustment (INVADJ) will no longer be allowed for most facilities.

Background:

Effective 2018-04 production month, the Ministry of Energy and Resources (ER) no longer allows the volumetric reporting activity type of **Inventory Adjustment (INVADJ)** for all facility types **except** pipelines (all products), waste plants (all products, excluding gas) and custom treaters (all products). This change is in response to audits performed by ER for the production years 2013 through 2016. Audit results indicate that the activity type was being misused and is unnecessary. This change will only affect volumetric reporting for the 2018-04 production month forward. If there are no other reporting options available to balance your facility, please contact PNG Support for guidance.

ER will continue to monitor the reporting of INVADJ for production months prior to 2018-04. In the future, ER will be implementing a change to generate errors and assess penalties for the volumetric reporting use of INVADJ for pipelines and custom treaters based on a percentage threshold, similar to waste plants.
