

Pipeline Splits/Oil Valuation – Allow Waste Oil code “WO” to be Used for Custody Transfer Point when Waste Plant is Out-of-Province

Audience: All Saskatchewan Users

Purpose: To inform Industry that as of November 2019 production month, waste oil functionality, “WO”, will be restored and available to Saskatchewan operators who ship oil to waste plants located outside of Saskatchewan.

Background: The Ministry of Energy and Resources (ER) is reintroducing waste oil functionality that will prevent generation of Oil Valuation records for Saskatchewan’s operators (Royalty/Tax Payer) and operators of the out-of-province waste plants (Purchaser).

The functionality is limited to receiving waste plants that are a Custody Transfer Point located outside of Saskatchewan. To report waste oil, operators in Saskatchewan will enter the “WO” code in the “Owner Contract” number field within the Pipeline Split functionality, in addition to submitting the other required fields. After submission, an oil valuation record will not be generated for both the Royalty/Tax Payer (SK operator) and the Purchaser (operator of out-of-province facility) involved in the transaction.

This change is on a go-forward basis and will be applied for prior period amendments from January 2019 production month.
