Audience: All MB Injection Facility Operators

Purpose: To notify MB injection facility operators of new requirements to report average well head pressure as of March production month (2022-03)

Background: Manitoba Natural Resources and Northern Development new regulations require injection facility operators report average well head pressure values for all active injection/disposal wells as of the 2022-03 production month.

A new “Avg. Pressure” reporting field is included on the Well Activity view of the Volumetric Submission screen (see below). Monthly average well head pressure is required on all wells reporting INJ (injection activity). Pressure is a numeric value reported within a tolerance range of 0 to 20,000kPa.

The new Avg. Pressure field will be available to users on April 6, 2022 to align with MB mandatory reporting requirements as of the 2022-03 production month. Pressure values will NOT be accepted for volumetric amendments in production months prior to 2022-03.

When viewing online in Petrinex, this field will only be displayed from the “well activity view” of an injection facility. Operators will be able to report this value online or via batch upload (xml or csv) as part of the normal volumetric reporting process.

The [Manitoba Spreadsheet Upload Specifications](#) and [Manitoba Spreadsheet Upload Templates](#) documents will also be updated as of April 6 for users who need to create csv volumetric submission files. The updates reflect the addition of the new Avg. Pressure field and the new revision number.
