Audience: All AB stakeholders

Purpose: This tip outlines the Volumetric Submission requirements for In-Stream Components (ISCs) and Energy at certain facility types.

Background: The Department of Energy (DOE) assesses royalty once gas volumes leave the 'royalty network'. This occurs when dispositions are made from an Alberta Battery (BT), Gathering System (GS) or Gas Plant (GP) to an out of network disposition. An out of network facility is any facility that is not an Alberta Battery (BT), Gathering System (GS) or Gas Plant (GP). For example, a meter station, injection facility or other facility types such as Custom Treater (CT), Miscellaneous (MC) or Other (OT).

In order for the DOE to accurately calculate the Crown royalty share, clients must submit the energy and ISC information related to all gas volumes leaving the network.

Procedures: Since August 2004, Petrinex has not accepted a gas volumetric submission that involves the facility types of CT, MC or OT (and involves an upstream BT/GS/GP) unless ISCs and energy have been submitted. This information **must** be submitted in order for the gas volumetric submission to be accepted.

Gas dispositions to a cross border facility in SK have been required in Petrinex since 2012-04. With the implementation of BC in 2018-11, Petrinex required ISCs for cross border between AB/BC. As of October 2019, if the ISCs are missing for a cross

border activity (DISP), Petrinex will display a warning message (VME0060- "ISCs are missing for a cross border activity. Details: ISCs are missing for activity [xxxx], product [xxx], and from /to identifier [xxxxxxxxxxx]. Please be aware there may be royalty implications if not corrected by reporting deadline.
